

Columns in Home Design

The most common mistake people make when choosing columns is selecting ones that are not proportionate for the scale of the property. Also, you should consider the material. Fiberglass columns are weather, decay and insect resistant, while PVC column wraps are virtually maintenance free, and relatively easy for the DIY installer, though not structural.
